

## **Mod Quads Class Supply List**

**The Mod Quads quilt pattern from Blue Underground Studios, Inc. by Janine Burke. This pattern can be found or ordered at most quilt stores or ordered on line from [www.blueundergroundstudios.com](http://www.blueundergroundstudios.com) . If you can't find the pattern, let me know and I will bring one to class for you.**

**1/8 yd. cuts of fabric. Each cut yields three blocks. Fat quarters can be used as well and will yield six blocks.**

**Separate pieces for the colored strips if the little strips are being cut from a different fabric than the blocks. These strips are cut 1 inch by 3 1/2 inches. In a 48" X 60" quilt there are 80 small blocks. These 80 blocks are put together in groups of 4 to create 20 large blocks (quads). You will need approximately 4 yards of fabric. You can make the quilt bigger by making more blocks.**

**Cutting Mat at least 18 x 24**

**Ruler for cutting strips. 6 X 24 is my favorite. A smaller one will work.**

**Hera marker ( optional ) This handy tool is used to press open your seams. Spend less time at the iron.**

**Thread: A neutral shade or matched to your fabric.**

**A new needle in your sewing machine**

**A sewing machine in good working order**
